## **Biography – Dr Sherene Devanesen**

Dr Sherene Devanesen obtained her medical degree from Christina Medical College of India, and Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Medical Administrators, Australian College of Health Service Executives and Australian Institute of Management. She is an experienced senior administrator with extensive experience in the health sector.

Between 1988 and 1995, Dr Devanesen worked in Mornington Peninsula Hospital, an accredited multi-campus teaching hospital of 436 beds providing a wide range of service, progressing from Deputy Director of Medical Services to acting Chief Executives when she left the organisation. Between 1995 and 1999, she served in The Peninsula Health Care Network as the General Manager, Acute Health Services, Network Director of Medical Services, Network Deputy Chief Executive and Network Quality Consultant. She was the Executive Director, Medical Services & Research for the Alfred Inner and Eastern Health Care Network between 1999 and 2000.

Currently, Dr Devanesen is the Chief Executive of the Peninsula Health. Peninsula Health has been servicing the Mornington Peninsula since it was first established more than nine years ago. Today it operates on an annual budget of \$215 million and is one of 12 integrated metropolitan health services operating in Victoria across multiple sites.

Peninsula Health features two acute hospitals and offers excellent subacute care in the areas of aged care, rehabilitation and palliative care. It also offers excellent psychiatric care for in-patients, the community and those undergoing rehabilitation. It also offers community health care as well as residential care in the aged and psychiatric areas featuring both high-care and low-care.

As the Chief Executive, Dr Devanesen reports to the Peninsula Health Board of Directors and its stakeholders including the State Government and the Department of Human Services.

## **Biography – Andrew Foster**

Andrew Foster was educated at Millfield School and achieved an honours degree in Philosophy, Politics and Economics at Oxford University.

From 1992 he became involved in the NHS, initially as a Non-Executive Director then as Chairman of an NHS Trust. This led to a period working as Policy Director (HR) for the NHS Confederation – a body which lobbies for and represents statutory NHS bodies. From this Andrew was appointed as Director General of Workforce at the Department of Health, a post he occupied until May 2006. In this capacity he had been responsible for all workforce issues for 1.3m NHS staff and oversight of over 1m staff in Social Care. The principal activities included:

- Designing and negotiating new pay systems for almost all staff
- Responsibility for a £4bn training and development budget
- Rapid expansion of the NHS workforce and trainees
- Modernisation of working practices including the ‘Skills Escalator’ strategy
- Workforce strategy, industrial relations and pay and employment policy
- Development of the HR function

In May 2006 he was seconded from the Department of Health to Blackpool, Fylde and Wyre Hospitals NHS Trust where he is now Director for Human Resources and Organisational Development. The Trust has a turnover of £200m, 800 beds, 4,500 staff and tertiary specialties in haematology and cardiac services.
