

Five areas for co-operation
between Hong Kong and the United Kingdom

- Hong Kong will host the Going Global 2011, an international education conference to be organised by the British Council from March 10 to 12 next year;
- The two sides affirm articulation between UK and Hong Kong's new education system, including the higher education sector;
- The two sides would collaborate further to attract leading UK school operators to set up international schools in Hong Kong to underpin Hong Kong's aspiration to be Asia's world city and a regional education hub;
- In support of the development of Hong Kong as a regional education hub, Hong Kong would support accreditation of UK qualifications for recognition under the Hong Kong Qualifications Framework (QF); and provide financial support for accreditation to eligible non-profit making UK providers of non-local courses, on the same footing as local providers; and
- The two sides would collaborate in sharing expertise in Information and Communication Technology in education to support improvement of schooling and development of Hong Kong as regional hub for educational services.
