Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service by the office steel date-stamp and two specially designed postmarks will be provided on 2 August 2011 at all post offices for official/private-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp is only available at the General Post Office.

Public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will open from 9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 2 August 2011 to provide date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
