Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service by the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 15 September 2011 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark as well as the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp is only available at the General Post Office.

Public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will open from 9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on 15 September 2011 to provide date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
