

Special Stamp Issue – “The 150th Anniversary of Queen’s College”
on 27 March 2012

This stamp sheetlet and the mini-pane are designed by Mr. TONG Wai-pang and printed by Joh. Enschede B.V. of the Netherlands. The stamp sheetlet is printed in lithography, whereas the mini-pane is printed in lithography with silk-screen glitter ink, embossing, lacquer and 22K gold plating with embossing.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service by the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 27 March 2012 at all post offices for official/private-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.

The public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 27 March 2012 to provide date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
