philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.

The public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 22 May 2012 to provide date-stamping service by the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
