\* CSD sets the level of earnings according to factors such as skill requirement of each job position and working environment, etc. For example, cleaning of workshops requires a lower level of skill and falls within “grade A”, whereas pattern making of garment requires a higher level of skill and falls within “grade F”.

# Inmates who are unable to work due to health reasons, or newly convicted inmates who are attending induction courses and are yet to be assigned any work may receive the basic level of earnings.
