## **Date-stamping Service**

For the first leg of the roving exhibition at the Hong Kong Museum of History, a philatelic posting box will be set up at the General Post Office and Granville Road Post Office from 19

December 2012 to 16 January 2013 for customers to collect the pictorial postmarks of the General Post Office and Granville Road Post Office respectively. In addition, commemorative cachets in four different colours, in a sequence of black, blue, green and red, will be provided at the Hong Kong Museum of History, the General Post Office and Granville Road Post Office in rotation during the four-week exhibition period.
