Serviced souvenir covers at \$5.9 each will be available for sale at the exhibition venue and at 37 philatelic offices on 28 December.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 28 December 2012 at the exhibition venue and 37 philatelic offices for official/privately-made covers bearing an indication of the event and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office. A cachet will be available for application on covers from 28 to 30 December at the exhibition venue during the exhibition period and 37 philatelic offices during normal office hours.

The public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 28 December 2012 to provide date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
