The stamp sheetlets are designed by Mr. CHENG Chi-ming, Carl. The \$10 stamp sheetlet is printed in lithography, and the \$20 stamp sheetlet is printed in hot foil stamping plus lithography, both by Joh. Enschede B.V. of the Netherlands.

## **Date-stamping Arrangements**

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 11 June at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.

The public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 11 June to provide date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
