

Hongkong Post “Love Post Day” – 9 October 2013

Posting Arrangements and Conditions

Definition of Personal Local Letter

- Sent by an individual to an individual, and bearing the name and the local address of both the sender and the recipient.

Permitted Posting Quantity

- Each person is allowed to post one personal local letter for free.

Packing, Size and Weight Limits

- Sent in an envelope or in the form of a postcard.
- Envelopes must be properly sealed. Unsealed envelopes are not accepted.
- Maximum size is 167mm x 260mm and minimum size is 90mm x 140mm.
- Maximum thickness is 7mm and minimum thickness is 0.25mm.
- Weight limit is 50g.

Address Format

- “Personal Letter”, together with the recipient’s name and address, must be marked on the envelope/postcard.
- The sender’s name and address must be marked on the back of the envelope or the postcard.

Acceptance Post Offices and Hours of Acceptance

- At specially designed collection boxes at all post offices during counter business hours on 9 October 2013.

Delivery Standard

- The letter will be processed on 9 October 2013. Following the pledge set for locally posted letters, the letter will be delivered on 10 October 2013.

Note:

- Letters posted at the special collection boxes will be date-stamped with “Postage Paid”.
- Letters not meeting the stipulated conditions may be refused or subject to surcharge.
- Registered, recorded delivery, Smart Post and Local CourierPost mail items are not covered by the free mail arrangement under the “Love Post Day” event.
- Promotional materials such as direct mail catalogues or commercial advertising materials will not be accepted.
