Date-stamping Arrangements for “Official Souvenir Cover to Commemorate the Closure of International Mail Centre”

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 8 March 2014 at all philatelic offices and the International Mail Centre Post Office for official/privately-made covers bearing the indication of issue date and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.

The public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 8 March 2014 to provide date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
