

Exhibition for the 13th Inter-School Stamp Exhibits Competition
(25 – 27 July 2014)

The Inter-School Stamp Exhibits Competition has been organized by Hongkong Post and co-organised by the Education Bureau to promote philately among students since 2000.

For the 13th Inter-School Stamp Exhibits Competition this year, the result was announced on 16 June 2014. An exhibition displaying winners and competition entries will be held at the Exhibition Hall, Heung Yee Kuk Building, Shatin from 25 to 27 July 2014.

The exhibition is open to the public and admission is free. The opening hours of the exhibition are:

25 July 2014 (Friday)	4.00 p.m. – 6.00 p.m.
26 July 2014 (Saturday)	11.00 a.m. – 6.00 p.m.
27 July 2014 (Sunday)	11.00 a.m. – 2.30 p.m.

To mark the event, Hongkong Post will issue a souvenir cover together with a special postmark and a cachet. Souvenir covers, priced at \$2 each, will be put on sale at all philatelic offices from 11 to 27 July. Serviced souvenir covers at \$6.2 each will be available for sale at all philatelic offices on 25 July.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service by the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 25 July 2014 at the exhibition venue and all philatelic offices for official/private-made covers bearing an indication of the event and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office. A cachet will be available for application on covers from 25 to 27 July at the exhibition venue throughout the exhibition period and all philatelic offices during normal office hours.

The public hall of the Hongkong Post Philatelic Bureau will be open from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 25 July 2014 to provide date-stamping service by the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the special postmark.
