- Works in progress. This date refers to the tender validity date of an important contract of the project.
- The Government intends to entrust the works to the WKCD Authority (WKCDA) for implementation under the construction/consultancy contracts already awarded by WKCDA. Subject to FC's funding approval, the Government will seek to incorporate the proposed works into the WKCDA contracts. The latter the decision to incorporate is to be made, the longer will be the delay to the relevant WKCDA contracts, and ultimately the higher the cost to the Government.
