<sup>^</sup> The number as at the end of the academic years concerned (i.e. August 31), representing the number of loan borrowers who should have started repayment in the previous academic years and the academic year concerned but are still in default on the date. A defaulter may default repayment in respect of more than one loan drawn down for courses from more than one category and therefore the total number of defaulters is not equal to the sum of the numbers of defaulters in each category. There is no direct relationship between the number of defaulters on that date and the number of applications and the number of students receiving loans in a particular academic year.
