Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 28 August 2015 at the exhibition venue and all philatelic offices for official/privately-made covers bearing an indication of the event and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide a hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently, but the GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office. A cachet will be available for application on covers from 28 to 30 August at the exhibition venue throughout the exhibition period and at all philatelic offices during normal office hours.
