

Medal for Bravery (Silver) (MBS)

Fireman Mr WAN Kin-wai is awarded the MBS in recognition of his act of gallantry of an extremely high order displayed during the firefighting and rescue operation in a No. 4 alarm fire at Amoycan Industrial Centre at 7 Ngau Tau Kok Road on 21 June 2016. Although the situation was fraught with danger, Mr WAN devotedly entered the maze-like mini-storages inside the industrial building to perform firefighting and rescue duties. During the operation, he braved the known danger in the hope of suppressing the fire at the soonest possible moment and effecting search for any possible casualty. In the course of retreat, Mr WAN lost contact with his Senior Station Officer partner. Even though he was injured, he attempted to retrieve his partner under the extremely dangerous situation. Mr WAN has displayed tremendous courage, professionalism, selflessness and strong commitment to duty in a highly hazardous environment.

Medal for Bravery (Bronze) (MBB)
