<b>Documents for enrolment</b>	Valid Hong Kong identity card and “HKSAR Document of Identity for Visa Purposes” with validity of not less than one month	Macau non-permanent identity card and “Visit Permit for Residents of Macao to HKSAR”, both with validity of not less than one month
<b>Enrolment locations</b>	Hong Kong-Macau Ferry Terminal Checkpoint; Taipa Ferry Terminal Checkpoint; Macau International Airport Checkpoint; Border Gate Checkpoint; Pac On Immigration Department Office Building	Immigration Headquarters, Wanchai; Macau Ferry Terminal; China Ferry Terminal; Tuen Mun Ferry Terminal; Kai Tak Cruise Terminal
<b>Enrolment arrangements for persons aged 11 or above and below 18</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Accompanied by a parent or guardian and provide the identification document of the accompanying parent or guardian;</li> <li>➤ Provide the enrollee’s original birth certificate (if the birth certificate is not in Chinese, English or Portuguese, it must be accompanied by a certified Chinese, English or Portuguese translation); and</li> <li>➤ If accompanied by a guardian, provide the original legal authorisation letter or court order (if the document is not in Chinese, English or Portuguese, it must be accompanied by a certified Chinese, English or Portuguese translation).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Accompanied by a parent or guardian and provide the identification document of the accompanying parent or guardian;</li> <li>➤ Provide the enrollee’s original birth certificate (if the birth certificate is not in Chinese or English, it must be accompanied by a certified Chinese or English translation); and</li> <li>➤ If accompanied by a guardian, provide the original legal authorisation letter or court order (if the document is not in Chinese or English, it must be accompanied by a certified Chinese or English translation).</li> </ul>
