




## Public Expenditure in terms of Percentage of GDP




# Comparison of Cumulative Growth in Public Expenditure with Cumulative Growth in GDP




# Comparison of Cumulative Growth in Government Expenditure with Cumulative Growth in GDP








#### Recurrent Public Expenditure by Policy Area Group






