# I. Commemorative Stamp Issue – "The 20th Anniversary of the Establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region" on 1 July 2017

This set of commemorative stamps is designed by Ms. Shirman LAI, and printed in lithography plus hot foil stamping by Joh. Enschedé B.V. of the Netherlands.

Official First Day Covers at \$1.30 each and Official First Day Covers (Prestige Version) at \$8 each will be on sale at all post offices and philatelic offices respectively from 16 June 2017. The stamps and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from the same day. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 16 to 22 June 2017.

This commemorative stamp is designed by Mr. HON Bing-wah and printed in photogravure by Beijing Stamp Printing House, the People's Republic of China.

Official First Day Covers will be on sale at \$1.30 each at all post offices from 16 June 2017. The stamps and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from the same day. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 16 to 22 June 2017.

### **Date-stamping Arrangements**

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmarks will be provided on 1 July 2017 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the

philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at GPO.

All post offices (excluding mobile post offices) will be open on 1 July 2017 from 9am to 1pm. The opening hours for the General Post Office will be extended from 9am to 5pm while public holiday operating hours for the Airport Post Office will be maintained from 8am to 5pm.
