### HA arrangement for Pneumococcal Vaccination 2017/18

Hong Kong residents aged 65 or above, include:  1. Patients with high-risk conditions attending HA outpatient clinics or being admitted as inpatients ; or  2. Comprehensive Social Security Allowance (CSSA) recipients or holders of a valid Certificate for Waiver of Medical Charges issued by Social Welfare Department	To receive one dose of PCV13 for those without previous pneumococcal vaccination history, to receive a mop up dose of 23vPPV one year later	25 October (2017)	SOPCs/ GOPCs for regular follow-up or hospital wards
	To receive an alternative mop up pneumococcal vaccine dose for those with previous pneumococcal vaccination history (For example, a dose of PCV13 would be provided to eligible elders with previous 23vPPV history and vice versa)	26 March (2018)
