Background information of PISA 2015

Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) 2015 was conducted under the auspices of the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), with 72 countries/regions participating in the study. The international study aimed to assess the scientific, reading and mathematical literacy of young adults aged 15, collect data on factors that could help to explain differences in performance, and evaluate the effectiveness of the education system in each participating country/region.

Having conducted in a three-year cycle since 2000, PISA 2015 was the sixth cycle. The main study of Hong Kong PISA 2015 was conducted in April to May 2015. A total of about 5,000 students aged 15 from 138 secondary schools participated in the study. PISA 2015 was changed from the previous written examination mode to computer-based assessment.
