Note 1:

Total tuition fee per cohort refers to the total fee for completing all years of study of the cohort. The normal duration of study of programmes under Subsidy Scheme 2 is four to five years.

Note 2:

Tuition fees of the programmes should generally be set with reference to the existing fee level with adjustments allowed for price movement in accordance with the Composite Consumer Price Index announced by the Government. Subject to the approval of Education Bureau, adjustments will be allowed for enhancement in teaching and learning if needed with full justifications. Justifications provided by institutions in applying for increase in tuition fee beyond inflation rate are set out in Annex 3.
