Special Stamp Issue – "Hong Kong by Night II" on 22 March 2018

This set of special stamps is designed by Mr. CHENG Chi-ming, Carl, and printed in lithography by Southern Colour Print, New Zealand.

Official First Day Covers each at \$1.30 will be put on sale at all post offices from 8 March. The stamps and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from the same day. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 8 to 14 March 2018.

All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.
