Special Stamp Issue – "Inclusive Communication" on 7 June 2018

This set of special stamps is designed by Ms. CHAN Ching-tsui, and printed by Cartor Security Printing, France. The stamps are printed in lithography plus Braille ink while the stamp sheetlet is printed in lithography plus Braille ink and lenticular.

Official First Day Covers at \$1.30 each will be put on sale at all post offices from 24 May 2018. The stamps and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from the same day. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 24 to 30 May 2018.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 7 June 2018 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.
