Besides, the Environmental Campaign Committee also supported four organisations to hold green LNY Fairs, where they shared recycling tips with members of the public, and redistributed materials with reusable value to organisations and persons in need. We did not collate statistics on the relevant wastes and recyclables of LNY years other than the one in Victoria Park, Causeway Bay.
