Special Stamp Issue: "The Hong Kong Section of the Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link" on 17 September 2018

The four stamps are designed by Ms. WONG Ling, and printed in lithography by Southern Colour Print, New Zealand.

Official First Day Covers at \$1.30 each will be put on sale at all post offices from 3 September 2018. The special stamp and associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from the same day. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 3 to 8 September 2018.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 17 September 2018 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.
