Definitions :

Killed casualty : Sustained injury causing death within 30 days of the accident.

Serious injury : An injury for which a person is detained in hospital as an 'in-patient' for more than 12 hours. Injuries causing death 30 or more days after the accident are also included in this category.

Slight injury : An injury of a minor character such as a sprain, bruise or cut not judged to be severe, or slight shock requiring roadside attention without admission to hospital or requiring hospitalisation for less than 12 hours.
