Special Stamp Issue – "Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area" on 26 September 2019

This stamp sheetlet is designed by a local stamp designer, Mr. Gideon LAI, for Hongkong Post and printed in lithography by Cartor Security Printing, France.

The stamp sheetlet features sketches of landmarks of the Greater Bay Area cities: Canton Tower of Guangzhou, Shenzhen Civic Center, Zhuhai Opera House, Century Lotus Sports Center of Foshan, Daya Bay Petrochemical Industrial Park of Huizhou, Sculpture at Dongguan Central Square, Zhongshan First Bridge, Kaiping Diaolou of Jiangmen, Seven Star Crags of Zhaoqing and Ruins of St. Paul's of Macao, as well as Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge and Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link and Golden Bauhinia Sculpture on Hong Kong side.

Order forms for full range of products are available at all post offices and Hongkong Post web site, and have been sent to account customers. The order deadline is 26 September 2019 and ordered products will be ready for collection by customers as from 30 October 2019. From 17 September 2019, Official First Day Covers will be put on sale at \$1.30 each at all post offices and the stamps and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 17 to 26 September 2019, with collection date on 30 October 2019.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 26 September 2019 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.
