Special Stamp Issue –“Hong Kong Hiking Trails Series No. 2: MacLehose Trail” on 24 October 2019

This set of special stamps is designed by Ms. CHAU So-hing, and printed in lithography and silk screening plus laser cutting by Joh. Enschedé Stamps B.V., the Netherlands.

From 10 October 2019, Official First Day Covers will be put on sale at \$1.30 each at all post offices and the stamps and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 10 to 16 October 2019.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 24 October 2019 at all post offices for official/private-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.
