¹ For a group training or class of more than 8 persons, it must be conducted in a way to ensure there is at least 1.5 metres between each person (except the coach) and the coach must wear a mask all the time if he is not staying at a fixed location not less than 1.5 metres from other persons.

² The following infection control recommendations must be applied to showering facilities: (a) keep social distancing between users of at least 1.5 metres by opening alternate cubicles or shower heads only; (b) carry out cleaning and disinfection of the shower cubicles at least once every four hours; (c) carry out regular environmental cleaning and disinfection on the facilities including storage cabinet at least daily; and (d) forbid sharing of personal items such as towel.
