Note: The above rehousing or compensation arrangement is only applicable to eligible tenants and non-owner-occupiers. Some of the tenants and non-owner-occupiers registered at the time of the Freezing Survey might not be eligible for the rehousing or compensation provided by the URA due to various reasons. As such, the number of households at the time of the Freezing Survey would not equal to the number of households offered rehousing or compensation.
