This stamp sheetlet is designed by Mr. Clement YICK, and printed in lithography with a screen of 600 lines per inch by Cartor Security Printing, France.

From 3 September 2020, Official First Day Covers have been put on sale at \$1.50 each at all post offices and the stamps and the associated philatelic products have been displayed at the GPO, TST, TSW, SCL and TCL. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers were accepted at all philatelic offices from 3 to 9 September 2020.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 17 September 2020 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the

philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the GPO.

For the stamp issue to be launched throughout the period of the pandemic, Hongkong Post will implement a special sales arrangement to achieve social distancing and prevent crowds. These arrangements, which shall be applicable to this issue, include:

1) Ordering of stamp products on the website, including a set of serviced first day cover with special stamps date-stamped with pictorial postmarks of all 38 philatelic offices, without the need to visit the actual outlets;

2) Collection points to be set up at all post offices on the issue date of the special stamps to facilitate the submission of order forms as well as first day covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
