Hongkong Post to issue: "Bruce Lee's Legacy in the World of Martial Arts" special stamps (Issue Date: 27 November 2020)

This set of special stamps is designed by Mr Gideon LAI Wai-kwan. The stamps, \$10 stamp sheetlet and mini-pane are printed in lithography whilst the \$20 stamp sheetlet is printed in lithography plus hot foil stamping with embossing by Southern Colour Print, New Zealand.

From 13 November 2020, Official First Day Covers have been put on sale at \$1.5 each at all post offices and the stamps and the associated philatelic products have been displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post office. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers were accepted at all philatelic offices from 13 to 19 November 2020.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 27 November 2020 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the GPO.

For the stamp issue to be launched throughout the period of the pandemic, Hongkong Post will implement special sales arrangements to achieve social distancing and prevent crowds. These arrangements, which shall be applicable to this issue, include:

- 1) Ordering of the special stamps and associated philatelic products on the website;
- 2) Collection points to be set up at all post offices on the issue date of the special stamps to facilitate the submission of order forms as well as first day covers requesting hand-back date-

stamping service.
