### Hongkong Post to issue “Together, We Fight the Virus” special stamps (Issue Date: 29 December 2020)

The stamp sheetlets are designed by Mr Arde LAM, and printed in lithography plus spot UV lacquer by Joh. Enschede B.V., the Netherlands.

Order forms for full range of products are available at all post offices and the Hongkong Post website, and have been sent to account customers. The order deadline is 29 December 2020 and the ordered products will be ready for collection as from 26 January 2021.

From 22 December 2020, Official First Day Covers will be put on sale at \$1.50 each at all post offices and the stamp sheetlets and the associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 22 to 29 December 2020, with collection date on 26 January 2021.

### **Date-stamping Arrangements**

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 29 December 2020 at post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the GPO.

For the stamp issue to be launched throughout the period of the pandemic, Hongkong Post will implement a special sales arrangement to achieve social distancing and prevent crowds. These arrangements, which shall be applicable to this issue, include:

- 1) Ordering of stamp products on the website;
- 2) Collection points to be set up at all post offices on the issue date of the special stamps to facilitate the submission of order forms as well as first day covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
