Hongkong Post to issue "Local Snacks in Hong Kong" special stamps (Issue date: April 22, 2021)

This set of special stamps is designed by Mr Colin TILLYER, and printed in lithography plus 3D embossing by Joh. Enschedé Stamps B.V., the Netherlands.

Official first day covers will be put on sale at \$2 each at all post offices from April 8, 2021. Display of the special stamps and associated philatelic products will be put up at General Post Office (GPO), Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office on April 8, 2021 for public's view. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from April 8 to 14, 2021.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on April 22, 2021 at all post offices for official/privately-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the "Philatelic Bureau" pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the GPO.

For the stamp issue to be launched throughout the period of the pandemic, Hongkong Post will implement a special sales arrangement to achieve social distancing and prevent crowds. These arrangements, which shall be applicable to this issue, include:

- 1) Ordering of the set of special stamps and associated philatelic products on the website;
- 2) Collection points to be set up at all post offices on the issue date of the special stamps to facilitate the submission of order forms as well as first day covers requesting hand-back date-stamping service.
