27 April 2021 Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from April 14 to April 27, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by April 29, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing who had been present at the specified premises from (c) to (f) choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottle with the sample by May 1, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between April 25 and April 27, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
