Note 5: Accordance to HKU's reply, since the HKU SPACE Community College is part of HKU SPACE (School of Professional and Continuing Education), it is difficult to disaggregate the surplus/(deficit) of Community College from that of HKU SPACE. Nevertheless, HKU advised that the HKU SPACE Community College breaks even on the whole.
