Note: While the year-on-year percentage increase in the number of newly registered PCs for recent years ranged only from 0.9% to 2.8%, the total number of newly registered PCs stood at about 45 000 per annum. After deducting approximately 20 000 PCs with vehicle registration cancelled annually in recent years, the growth rate in the total number of registered PCs was around 4% per annum.
