Commemorative Stamp Issue –
“The Bicentenary of Ying Wa College”
on 9 November 2018

This stamp sheetlet is designed by Mr. Freeman LAU and printed in lithography by Cartor Security Printing, France.

Official First Day Covers at \$1.30 each will be put on sale at all post offices from 26 October 2018. The stamp sheetlet and associated philatelic products will be displayed at the General Post Office, Tsim Sha Tsui Post Office, Tsuen Wan Post Office, Sha Tin Central Post Office and Tuen Mun Central Post Office from the same day. Advance orders for servicing self-provided covers will be accepted at all philatelic offices from 26 October 2018 to 1 November 2018.

Date-stamping Arrangements

A hand-back date-stamping service using the office steel date-stamp and the special postmark will be provided on 9 November 2018 at all post offices for official/private-made covers bearing the first day of issue indication and a local address. All philatelic offices will also provide hand-back date-stamping service using the “Philatelic Bureau” pictorial postmark and the philatelic office pictorial postmark concurrently. The GPO-1 date-stamp will only be available at the General Post Office.
