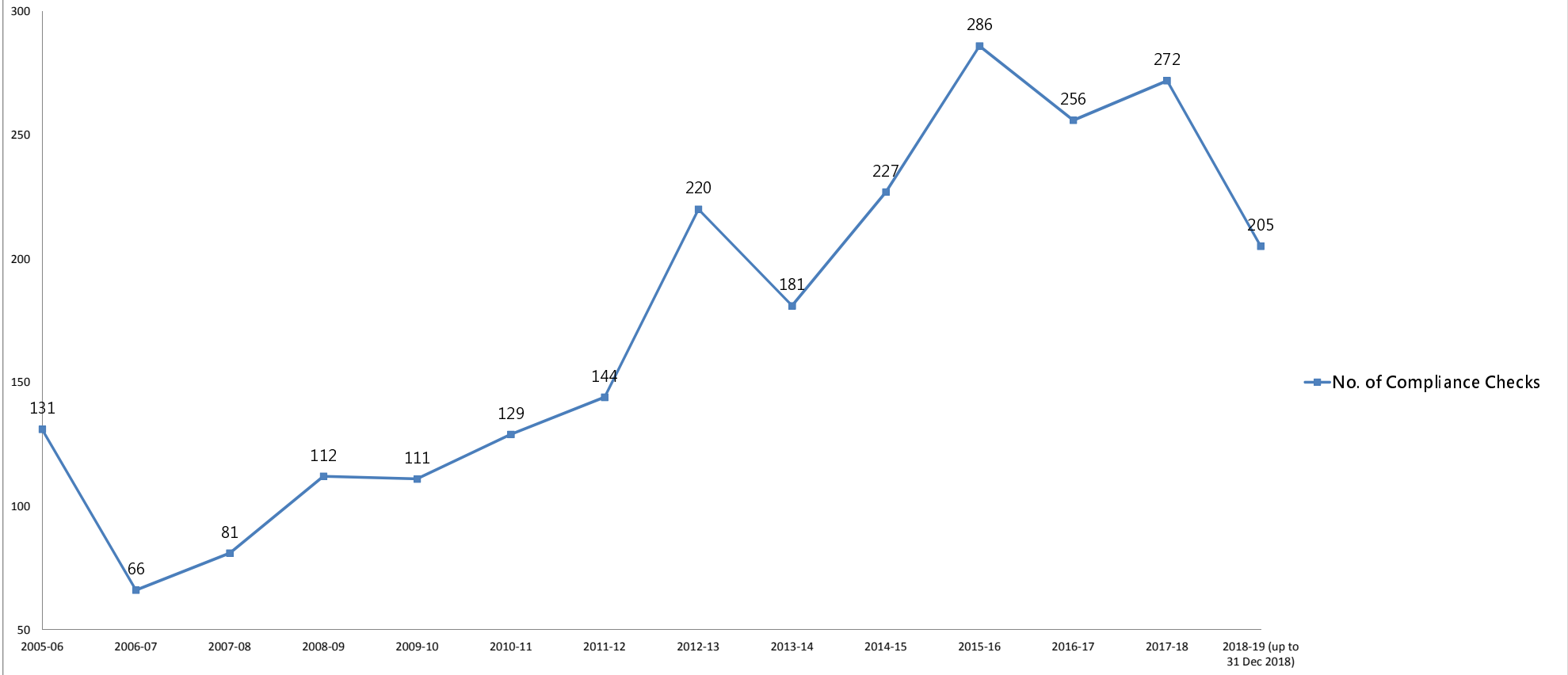
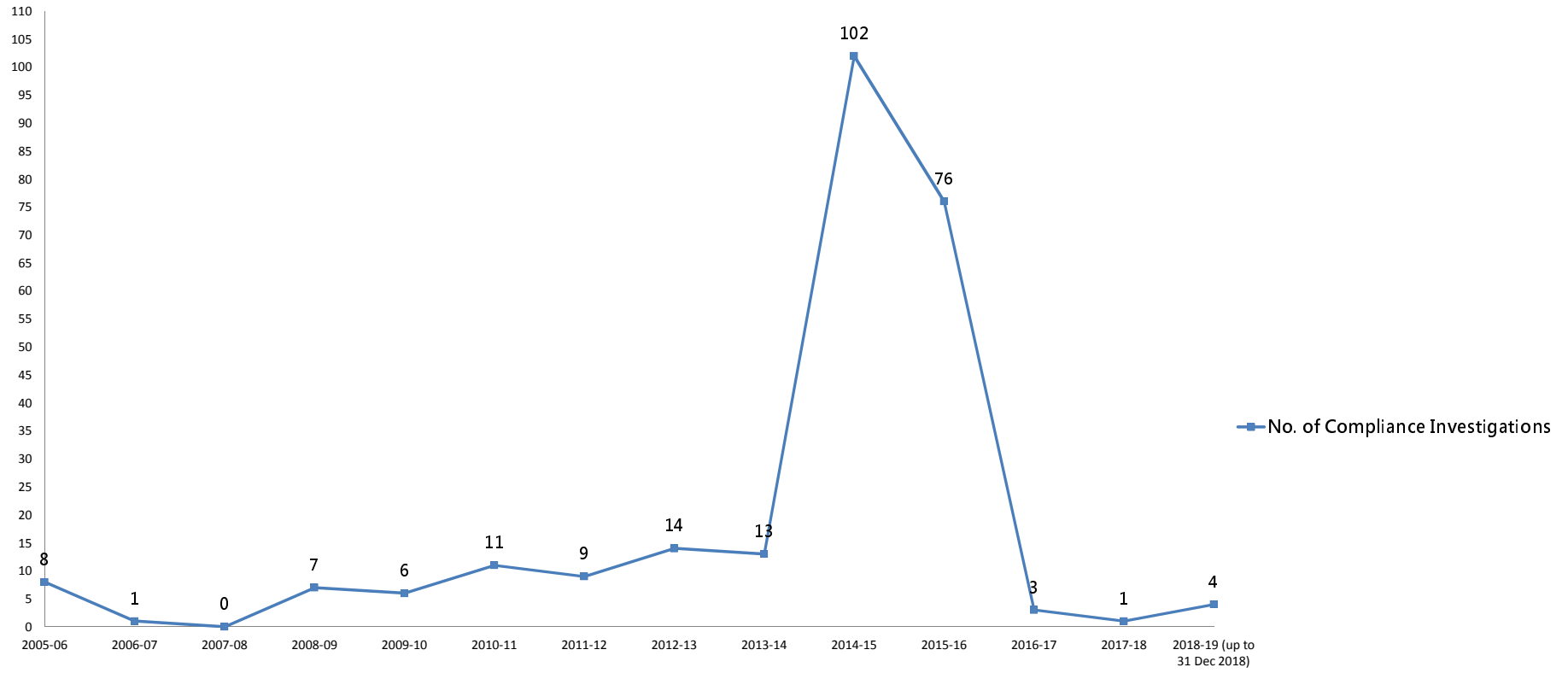


Number of Compliance Checks from 2005/06 to 2018/19 (up to 31 Dec 2018)
