

## Requirements imposed by the Secretary for Food and Health under Cap 599F and 599G

	Requirements (from 10 April to 23 April 2020)
<b>Catering business premises</b> with food or drink for consumption on site	<p>(I) Requirements on all Premises</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Service area must not exceed 50% of normal seating capacity</li> <li>b. Tables 1.5m apart or effectively partitioned</li> <li>c. No more than 4 persons each table</li> <li>d. Must wear mask except when eating/drinking</li> <li>e. Screen body temperature</li> <li>f. Provide hand sanitizer</li> </ol> <p>(II) Other requirements</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>g. Suspend karaoke and mahjong-tin kau activities</li> <li>h. Any premises (commonly known as bar or pub) that is exclusively or mainly used for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquors for consumption in that premises must be closed</li> <li>i. Any part of a catering business premise that is exclusively or mainly used for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquors for consumption in that part must be closed</li> </ol>
<b>Scheduled premises</b>	<p>] ] Amusement games centre, bathhouse, fitness centre, place of entertainment, place of public entertainment, “party room”, club or nightclub, karaoke establishment, ] mahjong-tin kau premises, beauty parlour, massage establishment must be closed ]</p>
<b>Scheduled premises : Club-house</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Suspend karaoke and mahjong-tin kau activities</li> <li>b. Must wear mask where applicable and except when eating/drinking</li> <li>c. Screen body temperature</li> <li>d. Provide hand sanitizer</li> </ol>
<b>Group gathering of more than 4 persons</b>	<p>] ] Prohibited in any public place unless exempted ]</p>
