

Requirements imposed by the Secretary for Food and Health under Cap 599F and 599G

Catering business premises with food or drink for consumption on site	<p>(I) Requirements on all Premises¹</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Tables 1.5m apart or effectively partitioned No more than 4 persons each table Must wear mask except when eating/drinking Screen body temperature Provide hand sanitizer <p>(II) Other requirements</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Suspend karaoke and mahjong-tin kau activities Any premises (commonly known as bar or pub) that is exclusively or mainly used for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquors for consumption in that premises must be closed Any part of a catering business premise that is exclusively or mainly used for the sale or supply of intoxicating liquors for consumption in that part must be closed

Scheduled premises : Club-house	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Suspend karaoke and mahjong-tin kau activities Must wear mask where applicable and except when eating/drinking Screen body temperature Provide hand sanitizer
Group gathering of more than 4 persons	<p>]] Prohibited in any public place unless exempted]</p>

¹ The requirement for the number of customers in the catering business premises at any one time must not exceed 50% of the normal seating capacity of the premises is suspended since 24 April.
