

The Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) Scheme

Rent Allowance

Under the CSSA Scheme, a rent allowance is payable to cover the cost of accommodation. The amount of rent allowance is the actual rent paid or the maximum rent allowance (MRA) appropriate to the number of eligible members in a family as fixed under the Scheme, whichever is the less. The MRA with effect from 1 February 2021 are as follows:
