Central Library COVID-19 Vaccination Centre

- 1. A male, aged 39, went to Central Library for vaccination. After receiving the vaccine, he felt dizziness and tremor. At 1158 hours, he was sent to Ruttonjee Hospital for treatment in a stable state and was admitted for observation.
- 2. A female, aged 69, went to Central Library for vaccination. After receiving the vaccine, she suffered from hypertension and generalized weakness. At 1554 hours, she was sent to Ruttonjee Hospital for treatment in a stable state. No admission was required.
- 3. A male, aged 48, went to Central Library for vaccination. After receiving the vaccine, he suffered from palpitation and hypertension. At 1848 hours, he was sent to Ruttonjee Hospital for treatment in a stable state. No admission was required.
- 4. A male, aged 45, went to Central Library for vaccination. After receiving the vaccine, he suffered from dizziness. At 1943 hours, he was sent to Ruttonjee Hospital for treatment in a stable state. No admission was required.
