<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The requirement that participants of the group gatherings must have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine does not apply to participants aged 15 or below. If participants aged 16 or above of the group gatherings are unfit to receive COVID-19 vaccination because of health reasons, they must make a declaration by using the specified form on the COVID-19 Thematic Website and present a medical certificate to the organiser of the group gathering or the premises operators. These two categories of participants (except those aged 5 or below)must present a negative result of a polymerase chain reaction-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 conducted within 14 days prior to or on the day of participating in the group gathering.
