

## Annex

For eligible social security recipients, the amount of the one-off extra allowance is equal to half of one month of the standard rate of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) payments, Old Age Allowance (OAA), Old Age Living Allowance (OALA) or Disability Allowance (DA). Examples of payment levels are as follows:

As regards the Working Family Allowance and Work Incentive Transport Subsidy Schemes, the one-off extra allowance is equal to half of the average monthly amount of approved months payable to the corresponding households/recipients in their most recently submitted applications in the period from October 1, 2020 to April 28, 2021, and eventually approved. The amount varies from case to case.
