**Details of Compulsory Testing Notice**

*(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course<sup>1</sup> would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)*

1. Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from May 15 to May 28, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by May 31, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by June 2, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between May 26 and May 28, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.

  - (3) The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Hong Kong Cheung Wah Kindergarten, Units 101-108 & 113-115, G/F, Cheung Fung House, Cheung Wah Estate, Fanling, New Territories, Hong Kong (Main School) and Units 102-107, G/F, Cheung Yue House, Cheung Wah Estate, Fanling, New Territories, Hong Kong (Branch)
  - (4) Christian Alliance Chen Lee Wing Tsing Memorial Kindergarten, G/F, Wing A & B, Yiu Cheong House, Tin Yiu Estate, Tin Shui Wai, New Territories, Hong Kong
  
2. Students of the schools at the levels specified below and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief teachers) of the specified schools

<sup>1</sup> If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before May 17, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before May 17, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before May 17, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 thematic website ([www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list\\_of\\_recognised\\_covid19\\_vaccines.pdf](http://www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list_of_recognised_covid19_vaccines.pdf)).

who had face-to-face lessons with such students at the specified levels during the period from May 15 to May 28, 2021 have to undergo testing by May 31, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between May 26 and May 28, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
