Details of Compulsory Testing Notice

(Persons who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination course¹ would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notices)

1. Any person who had been present at any of the below specified premises for more than two hours at any time during the period from May 26 to June 8, 2021 (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief staff, students and visitors), has to undergo testing by June 10, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing choose to undergo testing using the specimen bottles distributed by the Centre for Health Protection, they have to return the specimen bottles with the sample by June 12, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 6 and June 8, 2021, they would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in the compulsory testing notice.
 - (1) Yan Chai Hospital Wing Lung Kindergarten/Child Care Centre, Room 107-120, 122 & 124, G/F, Choi Yuk House of Choi Yuen Estate, Sheung Shui, New Territories, Hong Kong
 - (2) Tsung Tsin Mission Graceful Kindergarten (Ma On Shan), Shop KG01, 1/F, Kam Tai Shopping Centre, Kam Tai Court, Ma On Shan, New Territories, Hong Kong
 - (3) Ho Shui Kindergarten Sponsored By Sik Sik Yuen, G/F, Shui Sing House (Block 5), Tin Shui Estate, Tin Shui Wai, New Territories, Hong Kong
2. Students of the schools at the levels specified below and teachers (including but not limited to full-time, part-time and relief teachers) of the specified schools who had face-to-face lessons with such students at the specified levels during the period from May 26 to June 8, 2021 have to undergo testing by June 10, 2021. If persons subject to compulsory testing have previously undergone testing between June 6 and June 8, 2021, they would be taken to

¹ If a person subject to compulsory testing has completed a COVID-19 vaccination course, he/she would be taken to have complied with the requirements set out in this Notice. For both the Sinovac COVID-19 vaccine (CoronaVac vaccine) and Fosun Pharma/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (Comirnaty vaccine), completion of the vaccination course in general means having received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine 14 days ago, i.e. having received the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before May 27, 2021. For persons previously infected with COVID-19, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty vaccine or one dose of CoronaVac vaccine 14 days ago, i.e. having received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine on or before May 27, 2021. For persons who received COVID-19 vaccines in places outside of Hong Kong and have received the recommended dose(s) as stipulated in relevant guidelines 14 days ago, i.e. having received all of the recommended dose(s) of COVID-19 vaccine on or before May 27, 2021, they will also be regarded to have completed the vaccination course of the relevant COVID-19 vaccine, subject to the vaccine used being included on the list of vaccines recognised for this purpose as published on the Government's COVID-19 thematic website (www.coronavirus.gov.hk/pdf/list_of_recognised_covid19_vaccines.pdf).
