Note 1: There were no rescue and drowning cases at water sports centres in the past three years.

Note 2: During periods provided with lifeguard services.

Note 3: Rescue cases refer to cases where swimmers get into trouble in the water and rescue operations are required (including all cases regardless of whether the swimmers need to be delivered to the hospital).

Note 4: The classification of drowning cases is based on the direct cause of death determined by the Forensic Pathologist.
